



Semen collection *Sheep & goats*

Limited number of registrations

During the fall of 2016, the Centre d'expertise en production ovine du Québec will be conducting a semen collection pilot project accessible to sheep and goat producers across Canada.

- » \$ 50 REGISTRATION FEE
- » COST : \$ 20 TO \$ 30 PER STRAW
- » PRIORITY TO QUEBEC PRODUCERS

Now that the CEPOQ holds all the permits required for semen collection, it is proceeding with the pilot project, **"Semen collection of small-ruminants"**.

Artificial insemination is a major tool that has allowed rapid genetic progress across many different species. Sheep and goat breeds can also benefit from this progress, and artificial insemination is also an important component of biosecurity strategies on our farms.

Producers who wish to increase the genetic quality of their flock and to market the semen of their breeding stock may now do so thanks to this new service. Collected semen may be used in Canada or for export.
